

KATIE TAYLOR BURSARY – TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2020

Scholarship Offer

This offer of scholarship is dependent upon all information supplied being truthful and accurate and upon fulfilment of the conditions of the scheme. Wicklow County Council reserve the right to withdraw the scholarship as a result of any error whatever in the information given by the candidate.

Conditions:

Scholarship holders will be expected to fulfil the regulations of their college/institution and to undergo every term examination or any other examination determined by their college.

Value of Scholarship

One bursary of €1500 will be awarded to the successful applicant for each academic year. The Bursary will be awarded for a period of 3 years (or for 4 years with the approval of the Council), provided always that funding is available. A student who receives a Bursary and then has to repeat a year will not receive the Bursary for that repeat year. Furthermore, it will be at the discretion of Wicklow County Council whether such a student will receive the bursary for the subsequent years of their course. Bursaries cannot be deferred.

Payment of Scholarship

The scholarship will be paid by Electronic Transfer directly into the student's bank account.

The first installment will be paid upon confirmation from the Registrar of the college that the student has been officially accepted on an approved course and she/he has been registered in that college/institution.

Grant payment will not issue without this confirmation.

Renewal of Scholarship

Continuation of the scholarship will be subject to the above verification from the Register of the College.

Reporting to the Local Sports Partnership

A short update of your sporting achievements and activity must be submitted every September, prior to payment being issued. Wicklow Sports & Recreation Partnership may, with prior notice, request you to take part in some promotional activities during the year.
